64 YEARS OLD WOMAN

DAY 1

Comes from her general practitioner to the medical award, because of:

- Ekstreme headache, specialy behind the left eye
- Nausea
- Vomiting



Medical history:

- 2 days before, sees doctor because of extreme headache
- Hypertension, stopped taking medication 5 years ago
- Stopped smoking 15 years ago
- Otherwise healthy
- Never experienced anything like this before



Objective findings:

- Bloodpressure 210/120
- Puls 110
- Temperature 37,7 degr. Celcius
- Photophobic
- Nausea
- Vomits
- Neurological intact



Treatment:

- Antihypertensiva

- Bedrest

- Painstillers

 - London-treatment: paracetamol, antiemetica,
benzodiazepine



Examinations:

- Bloodtests, infection, kidney-, liver tests
- Bloodcultivation
- 24 hour urine sampling for catecholamines
- Continuous bloodpressure measurement
- Telemetry



DAY 2

- Continuous BP- the lowest 190/100
- CRP 54
- Total-cholesterol 8,0
- Morfin (because of the headache)
- CT-cerebrum, normal
- Urine sampling forgotten, starts over
- Lumbar puncture



DAY 3





HERPES ZOSTER OPHTHALMICUS

- Aciclovir
- Eyedroplets (kloramfenikol, zovir)
- Painstillers
- Cerebrospinal fluid: PCR positive Herpes Zoster
- Meningo encephalitis!!



WEEK 2

- Still much pain.
- Cerebrospinal fluid: PCR- negative for Herpes Zoster
- Stop Aciclovir treatment
- Continue painstillers
- Gabapentin
- Cutaneus morfine
- Laxantia
